The mechanisms and the benefits of its supplementation on hepatic disorder also have been highlighted in this review. Overall, this is a well-written manuscript with adequate information on previous study findings. The authors cited sufficient references in this manuscript.

- Specific comments are as follows:
- Title can be more elaborated.
- Abstract: Line 3: “fatty metabolism” will be changed to “fat metabolism”.
- Abstract: Line 6: “benefits effect” will be changed to “beneficial effect”.
- Author did not mention the methods of finding the literature for review.
- It would have been better if the authors use sub-heading for the common findings of the literature in the manuscript.
- Literature review can be omitted in the conclusion part. All these review can be included in the review section of the manuscript.
- English editing could be useful.

I have read this submission. I believe that I have an appropriate level of expertise to confirm that it is of an acceptable scientific standard, however I have significant reservations, as outlined above.
