The references are numerous and relevant to the topic; in the reviewer's opinion an additional source that could possibly further enrich the article could be: Suslo R, Trnka J, Siewiera J, Drobnik J, Ondine's curse - genetic and iatrogenic central hypoventilation as diagnostic options in forensic medicine; Adv.Exp.Med.Biol. 2015, Vol.861: Neuroscience and respiration.
