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Article Title: Diabetes, Hypertension, & Cognition: Effects of Medications and Education Level

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In my opinion, the manuscript is very interesting. A background is presented and the theoretical model is adequate. The sample is valid (the HRS should have been properly referenced) both the number and the selection procedure of participants. The results are explained carefully and faithful to what, badly, shown in the tables. I think Table 2 and Figure 2 should be clearer.

Discussion is concise and well explained; the study's limitations, although already presented in the abstract, should be further explained.

It would also be interesting to observe if the results are similar to the used dependent variable, the total cognition score, with validated test scores as the MMSE, GDS, etc.

I have read this submission. I believe that I have an appropriate level of expertise to confirm that it is of an acceptable scientific standard, however I have significant reservations, as outlined above.
