This study is well written and made a good effort in trying to construct and validate a multidimensional scale of intervention practices and behaviours for preventing falls among the institutionalized elderly. However, minor changes could be made.

1. In the Introduction section, the authors could add the prevalence and incidence of elderly people with falls in Europe (not only in Great Britain).
2. In the Methods section, the authors should define better the inclusion/exclusion criteria.
3. In the Conclusion section, the authors should report the study limitations.
