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Article Title: Role of Therapeutic Plasma Exchange in Hypertriglyceridemic Pancreatitis: A Systematic Review

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Review Report

The paper by Jaiswal P and co-workers is a review of investigations which compared plasmapheresis vs standard of care in the treatment of pancreatitis caused by severe hypertriglyceridemia. They found five retrospective studies but with limited samples and heterogeneous outcomes, concluding that there are few evidences to recommend or refuse plasmapheresis for the treatment of acute pancreatitis in patients presenting with high serum triglyceride levels.

I completely agree with the Authors about the need of randomized well-designed trials on this topic. Thus, I would recommend the publication of the present manuscript. A careful revision of the English language is recommended.
