From an epidemiological point of view, this is a well planned and written narrative review. So, I have only some minor comments:

- If available, it would be very useful to have prevalence/incidence data stratified by geographical macro areas or continents.
- "Vimentin can help to identify endometrial adenocarcinoma" some more details would be useful for the reader, not expert in urology (a VIM gene coded protein...).
- Among the cited studies, are there some RCTs? If any, it would be good to underline them.
- Ta cancer should be labeled also as "non-invasive papillary carcinoma."
- Survival rates: are you speaking about OS or PFS? Please, clarify this point.
- "Cox regression analysis" are you speaking about OS or PFS? These results should be properly and numerically cited, since they are so scarce.

I have read this submission. I believe that I have an appropriate level of expertise to confirm that it is of an acceptable scientific standard, however I have significant reservations, as outlined above.
